Raffle Fly of the Month "The Bunny Leach"

Materials:

Hook: streamer, sizes 2-10. Weight the hook with either a bead head or wire wraps; most of the weight should be in the front half of the fly.

Thread: To match body

Eyes: Lead weighted eyes

Tail: Thin strip of straight-cut rabbit, on the skin.

Body: Thin strip of cross-cut rabbit. Two tone or same color

Tying Instructions:

1. Start the thread at the eye of the hook and wrap the hook shank $\frac{1}{4}$ of the way back.

2. Tie in lead eyes by using a figure eight wrap and secure tightly

3. Wrap the thread up to the eye of the hook and tie in a light colored zonker strip.

4. Make sure the light color is on top, as the weighted eyes will cause the fly to turn over on retrieve.

5. Tie in the darker zonker strip on the bottom

6. Tie off your fly using a whip finisher

7. Take the bottom zonker strip and poke it through the hook point

8. Glue the top and bottom zonker strips together



RECIPES

You should fish the bunny leech by casting it down and across the stream. Strip the fly back toward you varying the retrieve as seems necessary to give the fly a natural appearance.
