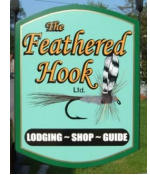

SAMPLE RECIPES

Nymph

Hook: Nymph hook 12-14

Thread: Tan or Brown

Body: Reddish Brown dubbing, pulled out from the thorax if you choose not to use partridge or wood duck for legs

Tail: Wood duck

Wing: Wing Case—Turkey

Rib: Fine gold wire

Legs: Partridge or Wood Duck (See Body)



Dry

Hook: Standard Dry 12-14

Thread: Tan

Body: Light pinkish tan dubbing (urine stained fox)

Tail: Medium Dun hackle

Hackle: Medium Dun

Wing: Wood Duck
