The Flash-back Pheasant
Tail Nymph



- Hook:** Mustad 80050BR—Size 14 or Match to suit
- Thread:** 8/0 Dark brown (or size/color to suit your fly)
- Weight:** Small lead wire
- Tail:** Pheasant tail fibers (8-10)
- Rib:** Medium copper wire
- Abdomen:** Pheasant tail fibers (12-18)
- Legs:** Pheasant Tail fibers (about 8-10)
- Wingcase:** UNI-Mylar 1/16" "Pearl" color (with a drop of 5 minute epoxy)
- Thorax:** Peacock herl
