Copper Candy

Hook: 9672 10 or 12

Hackle: Partridge

Body: Bronze color pheasant tail fibers, ribbed with thin silver or copper wire
Thorax; Nice bunch of peacock herl wrapped around the hook

Tail: Bronze Mallard in split-tail style

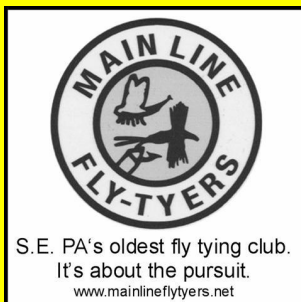

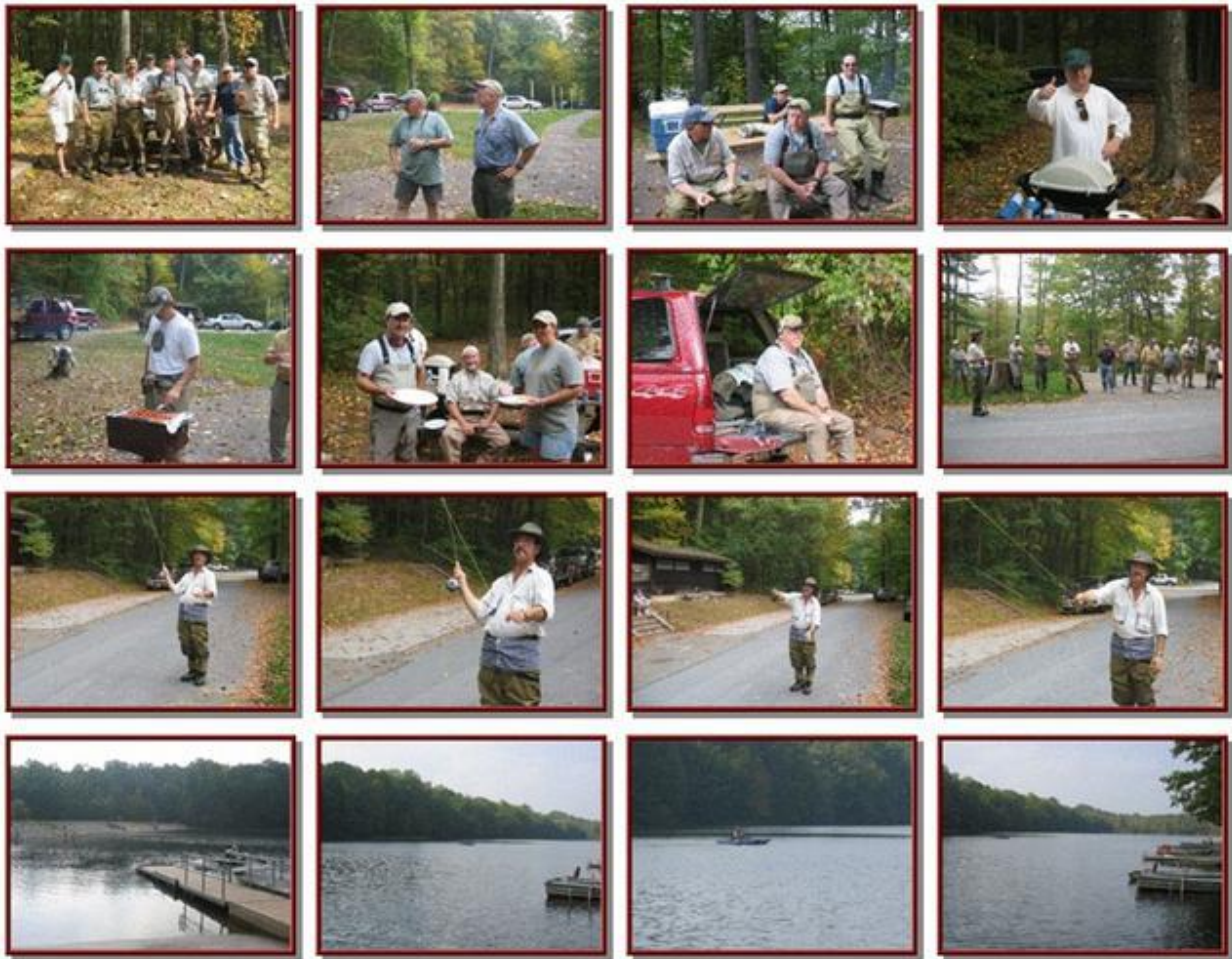
